REGULATIONS SURVIVING IN TERMS OF

Stamp Duties Act 15 of 1993
section 36(2)

**Regulations concerning the Demonetization
and Withdrawal of a Particular Issue of Stamps**

Government Notice 13 of 1990

(GG 33)

came into force on date of publication: 15 June 1990

These regulations were made by the State President in terms of section 33 of the RSA Stamp Duties Act 77 of 1968, which was repealed by the Stamp Duties Act 15 of 1993. They survive pursuant to section 36(2) of the Stamp Duties Act 15 of 1993.

ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

[The individual regulations have no headings.]

1. Subject to the provisions of section 32(1)(d) of the said Act and regulation 2, the issue of adhesive revenue and penalty stamps referred to in Government Notice R. 1133 of 2 June 1978 of the Republic of South Africa shall be regarded as demonetized and withdrawn with effect from 21 June 1990.

2. The provisions of regulation 1 shall not apply to revenue or penalty stamps overprinted for special purposes, including for the purpose of consular service.

3. The regulations promulgated under Government Notice R. 1132 of 2 June 1978 of the Republic of South Africa, are hereby repealed.
