

# Republic of Namibia Annotated Statutes

## **Appropriation Act 9 of 1999**

(GG 2137) came into force on date of publication: 9 July 1999

### **ACT**

To appropriate amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2000.

(Signed by the President on 24 June 1999)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

#### Appropriation of amounts of money for financial requirements of the State

1. Subject to the provisions of the State Finance Act, 1991 (Act No. 31 of 1991), there are hereby appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2000, as a charge to the State Revenue Fund, the amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

#### **Short title**

2. This Act shall be called the Appropriation Act, 1999.
